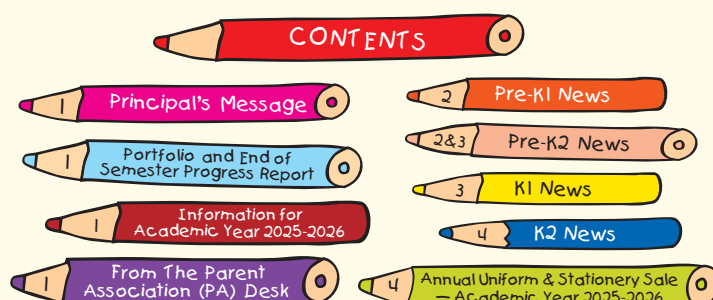

Pre-K1 News

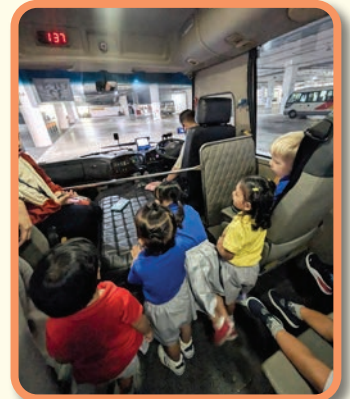
